Minutes of the Meeting, June 4, 2016

**Welcome and Introductions:** President Larry Lynch called the meeting to order at 10:20 am.

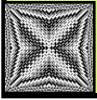
**Treasurer’s Report:** Treasurer Karin Roepel announced that there was a balance of \$2,842.71, but that she would be writing checks and this balance would change.

**Old Business:**

- A proposal to fund a FiberWorks 2016 award tabled at the April meeting was again brought up to the membership. A motion was made by Gina Levesque to fund a \$500 “Tulsa Handweavers Guild Award for Technical Excellence in Weaving”. The motion was seconded by Jim Black. The motion was carried. Treasurer Karin Roepel was tasked with sending the check to FAO.
- The September Meeting would fall on Labor Day weekend. The membership decided to change the date of the September meeting from September 3rd to September 10th. Unfortunately the library is unavailable on the 10th. Lyn Lucas suggested that once again the Methodist Manor be considered to host the September 10th meeting. The membership agreed. Karin Roepel made a motion to provide a \$75 fee to Oklahoma Methodist Manor for the use of the room. The motion was seconded by Lynn Tedder. The motion was passed. Lyn Lucas and two of the Methodist Manor weavers, Mae Timmons and Jill Hoilien, invited those attending the September meeting to tour the weaving study following the meeting.
- It was announced that THG bookmarks are available for dispersal.
